On **Friday 26th June**, our Year 1 students will be involved in a very exciting incursion provided by **Starlab Education**.

This incursion program is based on the Australian curriculum demonstrating observable changes in the sky. Students experience a simulation of sunrise, sunset, day and night to see stars, planets, the Moon and constellations. Students are taken on a virtual trip into space to discover how the seasons work with Annie, Max and their robot Kelvin in 'TILT'.

This activity has been tested for safety and students will be supervised by their class teacher. Sessions will be 60 minutes each, held in the MPC and will be run by an experienced presenter.
